

Online Classes by Schools




Online Classes being conducted by St. Xavier's HSS through whatsapp and Google classroom




Online Classes being conducted by Aeroville Higher Secondary school through whatsapp and Youtube








Feedback from students and parents for online Classes

Each house had five songs to present. It could be solo or duet.


The uploading of the songs was supposed to be completed by 2 pm on Sunday 14th June 2020.
